#### THE 200 CLUB

#### **Jill Howard Legacy Fund**



A reminder that we have invested most of the fund in several high interest accounts for 12 months giving an aggregate 5.77% return. We have kept £15,000 back in our everyday savings account for the first spend from the fund in 2024. As previously stated we want to use the money each year on projects that we believe Jill would have appreciated and would welcome

ideas on this. We will update early in 2024 when some decisions have been made.

#### FoT Final Spend 2023 & Projected Spend 2024

We are approaching the end of the season and so are looking at the FoT budgets for next year. The initial estimates are that our projected spend will be around £55,000. Our Covid years war chest has sustained a high level of spending for a couple of years but we now need to budget for a lillte less going forward. Our spend for this year has so far been £61,538.23 but our full year spend is now forecast at around £65,700.
