Reflections

Remarkably it is now seven years since we created Friends of Tournament (FoT) to raise money to support both the elite end of the sport and grassroots development. As you can see in the statistics on page one almost a quarter of a million pounds has been raised thanks to the generosity of all the FoT supporters and of this £206,000 has been spent supporting the sport here in the UK.

Half the money raised each year supports our elite skiers with Participation Grants to help towards the costs of going to European and World Championships.

The other half is spent on various "Development" initiatives. The main one being the annual programme of Development Days providing top level coaching to young skiers generally not yet competing in competitions. In 2023 this programme culminated in 27 youngsters attending the first Youth Festival event at the National Championships. Support is also given for Backyard Competitions, various Training Camps, Squad Training Days and our loan kit scheme.

But we are limited in what FoT does simply due to lack of people to help organize and run some of these activities.

Despite this FoT has achieved more in it's first seven years than we ever thought possible. Hopefully this momentum can be built on in the next seven years.

Jill Howard Legacy Fund



We have already received £205,000 and I final payment anticipated to be around £10,000 is expected to be paid in the next few weeks. The bulk of the money is on deposit for 12 months with an interest rate of 5.77%. Decisions will be made in the coming months on how Jill's wonderful legacy will be used.
