### **Jill Howard Legacy Fund**

We invested most of the Jill Howard Legacy Fund Money across three savings accounts with the Charity Bank, Sainsburys Bank and the Aldermore Bank with an aggregate interest rate of 5.77%. The Charity Bank deposit was for a 9 month fixed term that ended on 8<sup>th</sup> July. The

interest accrued was a total of £2,897.34. The total amount has been reinvested for a 2 year fixed term with an interest rate of 5.00%.

The other two accounts were for a 12 month fixed term and will come up for review early October. After taking some money out for the 2025 JHLF spend the rest will again be reinvested with much of it for more than one year.

One of the initiatives that we hope to do annually is a Jill Howard Memorial Ranking List competition. We have not been able to organize it for this year but are looking for a club to host it in 2025. Please get in touch with us if your Club is interested.

### **Development Days 2024**

The first seven Development Days of 2024 have taken place and have been very well received by all the participants. These are aimed at U17 youngsters who are developing but not yet competing in competitions. There is a notional cost of £20 per event with a maximum of 8 participants for each day ensuring that all get plenty of time on the water.

Our projected spend (excluding the JHLF) in 2024 is now around £53,200. This together with £17,000 from the JHLF means a total spend of around £70,200.

This has reduced due to fewer than expected skiers going to European and World Championships.
